What a great week we have had. The students in Room 15 are the best in the bunch. I am truly enjoying our time together. We have started the school year off and running. Language Arts

This week in Language Arts we have read the story selection "Class President." Ask your child to tell you about the story and to tell you what characteristics you would want in a leader. On Friday, we took the story test together so that the students would understand what my expectations are for the test each week. Fridays will typically be test day. We will take our Daily Language Review test, spelling test, Math 4 Today and our Open Court Story test. The story tests will be open book for the first trimester. I will be showing the students how to use the book as a resource.

In PE we practiced using Frisbees. The students practiced throwing and catching and seeing how many catches they could make in a row. They also practiced distance throwing.

Many students have taken advantage of these assignments this week. I will be leveling the students for math within the classroom. All students will be working on the same concept, they will just be working on problems at their level.
